**Product Description:** (a) Student player for Boom Cards, (b) Student reports view of performance on Boom Cards, and (c) Boom Cards interactive lessons and activities built by educational professionals. Includes conformance report for third-party Boom Cards that can be purchased through the Boom Store (UGC user-generated content). For engaging in learning content, all students should find the app useful and engaging. Educators will filter and assign lessons appropriate to each student's abilities.

For UGC Boom Cards we have accessibility support for vision, hearing, and mobility challenges. The Boom Studio has tools to create decks with accessibility features. Starting in August 2025, all Boom Cards published to the Boom Store must indicate if they offer motoric, auditory, and/or visual accessibility features. Because the catalog supports a range of cognitive and physical challenges, not all materials are suitable for all users. Using the accessibility feature filters allows educators to find right-fit materials.

The Student reports view provides graphic visual reports of individual student performance. For a visually-impaired student, these reports are annotated, but largely not useful.
